Fees – Terms and Conditions

1. Please make cheques payable to P McMeechan
2. All fees should be paid prior to the first class of term/ ½ term by post to 131 High Street, Buntingford, Herts, SG9 9AF or in person when your child attends their first class of the term/ ½ term.
3. Notice must be given prior to the beginning of the ½ term if a pupil wishes to stop classes. If no notice is given then fees will become due on the first day of the term/ ½ term and must be paid.
4. A fees letter is issued each term. You may choose whether to pay for the whole term or half-termly. If you do choose to pay half-termly then no reminder letter is sent.
